




- The sprint timeline divides the development process into "sprints," or timeboxes of work.
- Each sprint has a goal, and at the end of the sprint, a review meeting is held to determine if the goal was met.



Sprint Timeline Outline




- It is a visual representation of the amount of time a team has to achieve its objectives.
- A sprint schedule is a document that details the sprint planning process from start to finish. It is one of the first steps in the agile sprint planning process, and it necessitates thorough research, planning, and communication.



Four Quarter Agile Product Development Sprint Roadmap



- **The product owner** typically determines the sprint duration and consults with the team to ensure that it aligns with the team's workloads and resources.
- While multiple project heads may be working together on a sprint, it is ultimately important to have one owner who oversees all aspects of sprint planning.

- Specific tasks & instructions







- **Sprint planning** is a key ceremony in the Agile Scrum framework.
- It is a weekly working session during the sprint that allows members of the scrum team to agree on product backlog items that will be accomplished during the sprint.





- The **Waterfall methodology**, also known as the Waterfall model.
- It is a sequential development process that flows like a waterfall through all phases of a project (for example, analysis, design, development, and testing), with each phase completely wrapping up before moving on to the next.







Principles of Agile development :

- Individuals and interactions take precedence over processes and tools.
- Working software takes precedence over comprehensive documentation; customer collaboration takes precedence over contract negotiation.
- And responding to change takes precedence over following a plan.

When to make a Sprint timeline?

- A sprint schedule should ideally be created early in the development process, before you get to the planning stage.
- Sprint schedules should be highly fluid in the beginning.
- You will almost certainly have to make changes before you arrive at a final plan on which everyone can agree.



How does agile test planning work?

An Agile Test Plan must possess a correct and straightforward structure that includes business inputs as well as QA tasks.It specifies the following topics:

- User narratives.
- The QA environment.
- The scope of the testing.
- The testing procedure.
- Dependencies and risks.
- Estimates and criteria for exit.



What are the phases of the agile software testing life cycle ?

The following are the **phases of the agile software testing life cycle**:

- Impact assessment.
- Agile testing strategy.
- Ready for release.
