



FAQs

What is the definition of a basic book report?

- A book report is an unbiased summary of the main ideas and arguments presented by the book's author.
- The purpose of the report is to provide enough information to help potential readers decide whether the book will be useful or interesting to them.

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What exactly is a storyline in writing?

- A storyline is the series of events that make up your story.
- Before writing the dialogues and scenes for your work, you can organise your storyline.
- The plot usually includes the following elements: Characters, Conflicts and Settings.

What is the synopsis of the short story?

- It usually focuses on a single significant episode or scene involving a small cast of characters.

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- Character is revealed in action and dramatic encounters but rarely fully developed; the form encourages economy of setting and concise narration.

How do you write a character description?

- Describe the appearance of their character.
- Describe their background and history
- Describe their movements

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- Describe how they communicate.
- Explain their actions, thoughts, and emotions.
- Describe their character.

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
